REFERENCE

The British South Africa Company owns the mineral rights throughout Northern and Southern Rhodesia, except over areas (bordered green and numbered 1, 2, 3 and 4) aggregating about 13,000 square miles. In areas Nos. 1 the rights have been wholly alienated, while in areas Nos. 2, 3 and 4 the British South Africa Company retains an interest in the rights. It also owns extensive mineral rights in the Bechuanaland and Nyasaland Protectorates. Exclusive prospecting rights over about 203,000 square miles in Northern Rhodesia have been granted to various Concession companies for limited periods. The Company owns about 5,983,000 acres of land (coloured green) including the Tanganyika Estate of approximately 2,667,853 acres, the North Nyasaland Estate of 2,498,230 acres, and approximately 600,000 acres being the remainder of the Tuli block. Large portions of the Tanganyika Estate and the North Nyasaland Estate are liable to be set aside as Native Reserves. The Company has the right to one-half of the proceeds derived by the Crown from the sale or lease of land in North Western Rhodesia until 1965.
